

What's on the Modern Seder Plate?

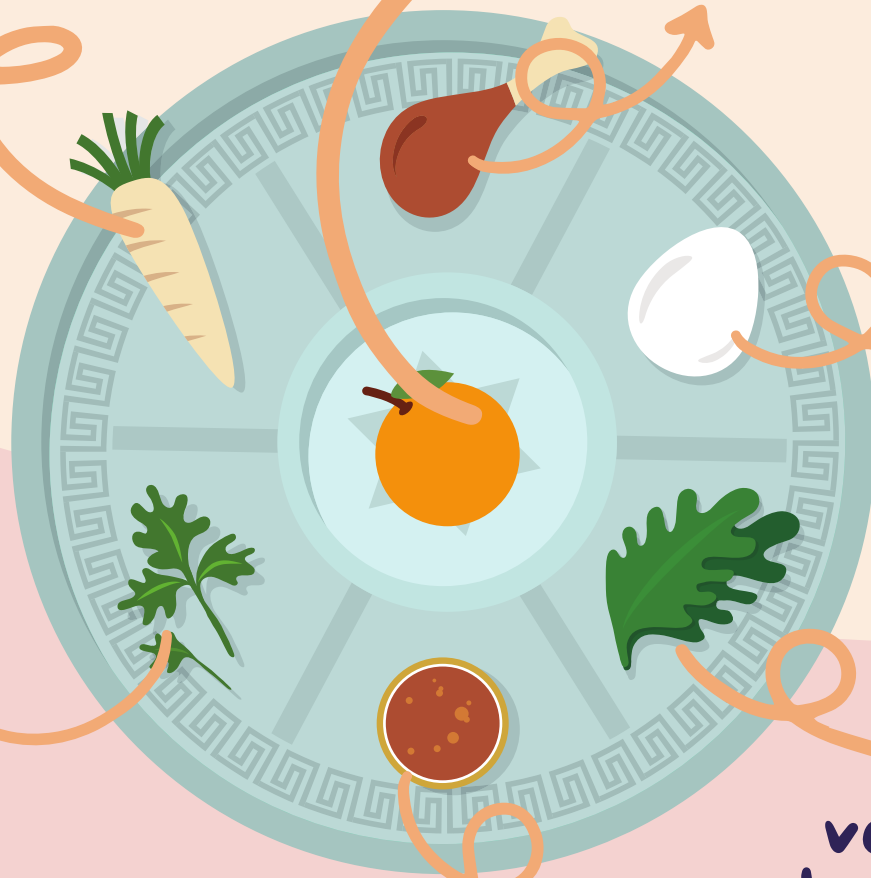


Tapuz - an Orange - newly added, linked to inclusion and equality

Zeroa - a roasted lamb shank / vegan option - to symbolize the Passover offering

Maror - Bitter Herbs/Greens, to show the bitterness of slavery

Beitzah - a boiled egg, round, just like the circle of life and renewal



Chazeret - More bitter herbs, used in making a "sandwich" with Matzah and Maror

Karpas - a fresh vegetable representing hope and new beginnings

Charoset - Like the mortar used by our ancestors!
